CLAT 2020 Exam Date

Consortium of National Law Universities announces date and made changes in exam

Changes in the format of questions –Clat 2020 Exam. From this year there will be a few changes in the exam pattern of Common Law Admission Test or CLAT 2020

The 'Common Law Admission Test' (CLAT) 2020 will be conducted on 10 May 2020. Notification regarding this will be issued in the last week of December, 2019.

In a press release issued by the Consortium of National Law University on Thursday, it has been told that the CLAT, 2020 examination will be held on Sunday, May 10, 2020. Online forms will be available from January 1, 2020.

In CLAT 2020, the number of questions has been reduced from 200 to 120-150. President of the Consortium, Prof. Mustafa said that it is not right to ask 200 students in 120 minutes. This puts a lot of mental pressure on the students. During a meeting held at the Consortium's Permanent Secretariat in Bangalore, the authorities have decided that "Comprehension based questions would be asked from Quantitative Techniques, English, Current Affairs, Deductive Reasoning and Logical Reasoning." Students will be given two hours to complete the exam.

Eligibility criterion

- Age no bar
- Candidates must have passed 10th and 12th from a recognized board with at least 45% marks (general category)
- 40% marks (reserved category).
- Students who will be appearing in the qualifying exam in March/April 2020 will be also eligible to apply.
